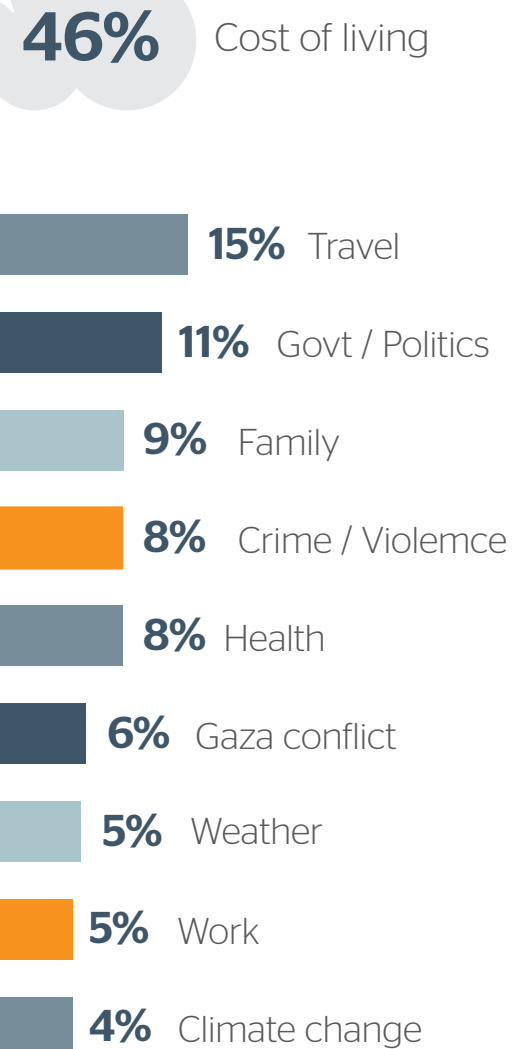

- » Camera (reversing / 360 degree view)
- » Fuel efficiency

Of those households with multiple vehicles, **over 90%** don't think they could get by with just one vehicle.
