

Activity 5: Make a safe, 3D skate park

Create your very own skate park model using the instructions below. Think about what you will have in place to encourage a safe environment and to encourage the safe use of bicycles, scooters and skateboards.

Materials:

- $\ensuremath{\,{\rm \tiny D}}$ A piece of cardboard bigger than A4
- » Coloured A4 paper
- » Cardboard rolls
- » Cotton tips
- » Textas or pencils
- » Glue
- » Other recyclable materials you want to use

Final Product

Instructions:

- 1. List a set of rules so riders can use your skate park safely.
- 2. Gather all the materials you want to use.
- 3. Use a sheet of paper or the cardboard as the base of the model.
- 4. Without using scissors, use the paper to make ramps, jumps, seats or benches and anything else you would like to include at your skate park.
- 5. When you have completed your skate park, use the cotton tips and a strip of paper and glue to make a person to play at the park.

Draw a picture of your skate park model. Show someone your model and explain what the paper represents as well as the rules you'll have in place.

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
