4.	Andrew tells Josh and Emily that it is only his second drink of the night. What might make this a dangerous or illegal situation?
5.	If you were in Josh or Emily's shoes, what could you say to Andrew to try and make him rethink his choices?
6.	Taking action - If you suspect your friend might be over the drink drive limit and is intending to drive, write down a few things that you could say that might help them rethink their behaviour and choices.
