Activity 3

In this video, Andrew leaves the party and meets James outside to give him a lift home. They walk past Claire who is waiting for a taxi, she is worried about getting home on time and asks for a lift. When getting into a car with anyone, you should know as much as you can about the driver and the situation you are in. Sometimes getting a lift with a friend might not be the safest option. Thinking about things that could make a situation like this unsafe, answer the questions below.

1. Claire calls shotgun and she and James run to the car. What visual clue appears that tells us more about Andrew the driver?

2. What other information about Andrew did you learn about in video 2 that Claire is not aware of?

3. What was Claire's initial Plan A to get home and why did it not work out?

4. Do you think Claire had a Plan B? What could her safe Plan B and C be?

5. Before getting into the car, James offers to drive - why do you think he did this?

Taking action - Imagine you had to rewrite the script. What could James say when Andrew says 'I've only had a couple...all good'?
