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Room for improvement for WA's riskiest roads

RAC has today released its 12 month Risky Roads campaign scorecard, revealing that work still needs to be done on the State's most dangerous roads.

RAC General Manager Corporate Affairs, Will Golsby, said the scorecard looked at the progress made on the roads that were nominated by the community as the State's riskiest roads 12 months ago.

"We acknowledge and welcome the construction underway on some of the roads identified, but we're extremely concerned that that work on the rest has not commenced," Mr Golsby said.

With over 5,000 nominations last year, the Risky Roads survey empowers community members to voice their concerns about dangerous roads and intersections, so authorities can get them fixed and ultimately try to save lives and stop serious injuries occurring on our roads.

Roads nominated including the Bussell Highway in Capel, Bruce Rock-Merredin Road in Merredin, Indian Ocean Drive in Lancelin, Albany Highway in Kojonup and Minilya-Exmouth Road in Exmouth have received no work to improve them, and 50 per cent of the riskiest intersections have no construction underway.

"These results highlight the urgent need for the State Government to deliver more funding, but the current State Budget only confirms a reduction in spending.

"This is on top of the huge backlog in road maintenance which was identified in 2009 by the Auditor General, and estimated to be \$800 million.

"Construction on these dangerous roads is critical because the road fatality rate in WA is too high. Tragically, we have already lost 124 loved ones on WA roads this year."

RAC is also continuing to urge Western Australians to be careful behind the wheel and drive to the conditions.

Risky Roads is WA's largest road infrastructure community survey and is undertaken to provide a snapshot of community perceptions, insight for road authorities and assist in identifying trends in traffic flow, infrastructure and safety.

1	Beechboro Road x Gnangara Road, Lexia	Inadequate crossing or turning opportunities and poor road surface.	✓
2	Ocean Reef Road x Edgewater Drive, Edgewater	Inadequate crossing or turning opportunities.	✗
3	Ennis Ave x Port Kennedy Drive, Port Kennedy	Inadequate crossing or turning opportunities. Speed of vehicles is too high and a confusing intersection layout.	✓
4	Mandurah Road x Surf Drive, Secret Harbour	Inadequate crossing or turning opportunities. Speed of vehicles is too high and a confusing intersection layout.	✗
5	Reid Highway x Malaga Drive, Noranda	Inadequate crossing or turning opportunities and an inadequate traffic light system.	✓
6	Berkshire Road x Roe Highway, Forrestfield	Inadequate crossing or turning opportunities and an inadequate and confusing traffic light system. Vegetation blocking visibility of oncoming traffic was also an issue.	✓
7	North Lake Road x Bibra Drive, Bibra Lake	Inadequate crossing or turning opportunities.	✓
8	Beaufort Street x Walcott Street, Mt Lawley	Difficulty turning right with existing traffic lights.	✗
9	Albany Highway x South Coast Highway, Albany (includes Chester Pass x Hanrahan x North Road x Albany Highway roundabout)	Confusing intersection layout with difficulty turning right from South Coast Highway onto Albany Highway and sight issues for left turning traffic. Significant conflict with nearby roundabout and high volume of heavy vehicle traffic.	✗
10	Tonkin Highway x Gosnells Road West, Martin	Inadequate crossing or turning opportunities, Speed of vehicles is too high.	✗
