WA local government strategic transport priorities

Local governments have unparalleled insight into local and community needs, which can help inform the identification and development of strategic transport priorities. In mid-2018, RAC conducted a survey inviting all local governments across Western Australia (WA) to nominate up to three projects which currently have partial or no funding that they considered to be of greatest importance for the future movement of people, as well as the economic productivity and liveability of our State.

This publication has been prepared to provide a summary of the survey results, reflecting the information provided by the participating local governments¹. A total of 125 projects were nominated by 58 local governments from Perth and regional WA. The total estimated cost of the nominated projects was approximately \$15.6 billion.

Transport related priorities and challenges

Local government priorities largely relate to maintaining or upgrading existing roads and improving the availability and amenity of public and active modes of transport. Funding availability was identified as a key challenge for local governments, both in regard to recurrent funding and the uncertainty associated with existing funding mechanisms. Also raised was the need for enhanced strategic direction for transport in Perth, Peel and regional WA, as well as improved transparency around spending on major transport infrastructure projects.

Other key challenges included:

- Managing population growth and ongoing congestion pressures;
- Managing increasing volumes of heavy freight traffic, its impacts on local road infrastructure and the associated road safety issues;
- Facilitating a shift towards more sustainable and active modes of transport;
- Dealing with declining capacity to fund road maintenance and upgrades / asset renewal; and
- Responding / adapting to and planning for the implications of disruptive technologies (mobility-as-a-service and automated vehicles).






